Tree is a highly interactive participatory performance for very young children and their grown ups, combining dance, theatre and music full of tactile props for each child to explore and movements to join in with. Based on the popular early years book 'Tree' by Britta Teckentrupp and themed on the seasons, the show has been carefully developed, researched and crafted for babies and toddlers, meaning that each moment is appropriately pitched in content, style & duration.

Cscape is a dance theatre company based in Cornwall and has created and toured work for 15 years to both indoor and outdoor venues. 'Tree' is the first in a series of shows for our Imaginarium project, creating high quality work for 0-5's.
